```

the same for cron parameter in roles/burp/tasks/client_specific_conf.yml:

```
- vars:
  cron: "{{ backup.value.cron if backup.value.cron is defined else hostvars[inventory_hostname]['backup_cron_' + backup.key] }}"
```
